Hamilton County Speedway Trailer Race Rules

General Rules:

- Competitors must be at least 16 years old.
- Drivers 18 years and younger must have a minor release form signed by both parents. No exceptions!
- Driver must wear a helmet with eye protection and a seat belt.
- Shoulder and lap belts are required. Racing harness is recommended.
- Driver must wear long sleeves and gloves while in the vehicle.
- No open toe shoes allowed.
- The driver is the only one allowed in the vehicle. No passengers. No exceptions.
- If the driver removes seat belt or helmet or leaves the vehicle (unless in the case of a fire or you are authorized to do so by track official), driver will immediately be disqualified.
- Depending on number of entries, more than one race may be run. If so, we will payout the top 4 in each race.
- The train must be connected and operational at the finish of the race to be scored.

Vehicle Preparation:

- Any size automobile may be used.
- Number needs to be visible on the side of vehicle AND on the trailer. No duplicate numbers. First to check-in gets number.
- No semis. No operational 4-wheel vehicle.
- Pickups and vans are allowed.
- Light duty blazers and SUV's are allowed.
- If vehicle is 4x4 you must remove front or rear drive shaft so that the 4x4 does not work.
- No dual wheeled vehicles allowed.
- No semis. No operational 4-wheel vehicle.
- No tow trucks. No school buses. No convertibles.
- All glass must be removed.
- All headlights, taillights, protruding trim, hardware, and hub caps must be removed for safety purposes.
- Driver side door must be chained or welded shut.
- You may use two (2) driver protection bars. You may use 1"x3" flat steel or maximum 2" diameter round or square tubing mount on the outside of the vehicle and not extending more than 12" past door seams.
- Factory steel bumpers only.
- Radiator guards allowed not to extend past bumper.

Hitch Preparation:

- Any type of factory hitch set up may be used. Example: ball hitch, pin hitch, pintle hitch.
- No 5th wheels allowed.
- No gooseneck.

Trailer Preparation:

- Any single wheel trailer.
- Minimum of 8 feet in length for the trailer bed.
- Trailers allowed: Campers, pop-ups, and boats.
- Campers and pop-ups must have LP tanks removed, as well as any loose material inside.
- Boats must have motors removed.
- Boats must be attached to a trailer.

- No farm implements. (ex: manure spreader, grinder mixers)
- Trailer must be carrying an object.
- Object must be secure to the trailer.
- Trailers must not have garbage, no porcelain or glass (sinks, stools, bathtubs).

Race Rules:

- Object of the race: finish race with your trailer still attached, while trying to separate the trailer of your competitors from their tow vehicle.
- Pole position: Determined by crowd vote. Loudest cheers start on the pole.
- If trailer comes detached, you're done. (disqualified)
- No vehicle-to-vehicle hits.
- Must only hit trailer.
- Vehicle to vehicle hits will result in disqualification.
- First vehicle to finish the race with eligible trailer OR last vehicle with eligible trailer attached wins.

Decisions of the officials are final. All rules are subject to change. Questions can be directed to the Hamilton County Speedway office.
